The Need in Our City:

Almost 3 million children in the U.S. grow up with a mom or dad in prison, and often these children, through no fault of their own, grow up feeling abandoned, lonely and ashamed.

How We Serve:

Angel Tree is a program of Prison Fellowship that connects parents in prison with their children through the delivery of Christmas gifts. Each year, St Pats “adopts” around 20 families in Greeley and delivers presents to the children in these families on behalf of their incarcerated parent. One parent sent a text of thanks saying, “I just wanted to say thank you so much! It’s such a blessing to not only us but other families that you all help out and it is GREATLY APPRECIATED! I’m so overwhelmed with joy right now! I can’t thank you enough. I let the kids open the gifts and they absolutely LOVE them! Thank you for ALL that you have done.”
