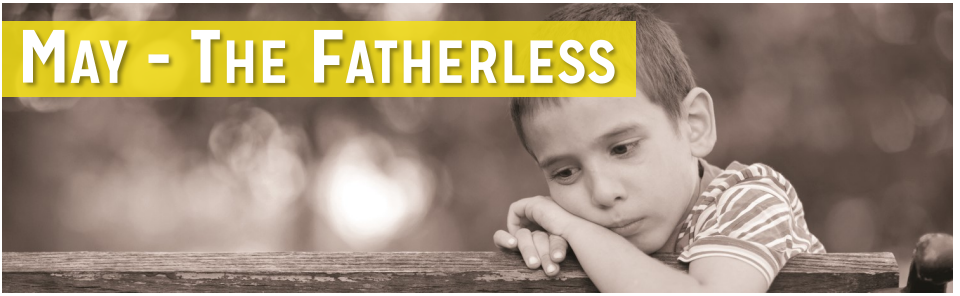


MAY - THE FATHERLESS

It is estimated that 140 million children worldwide are orphans. Over 100,000 foster children in the U.S. are eligible and waiting to be adopted, and each year Weld County struggles to find enough foster parents.

How We Serve:

Not everyone at St Pat's is called to be a foster parent or adopt a child, but we want to continually bring attention to the incredible need that exists. Through the Weld Faith Partnership St Pats is working with other congregations to help support 35 foster and adoptive families by providing education, friendship, and practical help.
